Minutes of the 1835 Town Hall Committee

April 11, 2018

Mr. Booth has designed a wheelchair lift, since we cannot afford a Lula--Mr. Booth also talked about the broken truss, that happened when the turnbuckles were too tight--There needs to be a ridge vent installed on the roof--The Committee chose the Highland shingles that resemble slate--100 slates will be saved for the Committee's or Friend's fund raiser--Mr. Booth talked about a smoke vent that will be located in the front of the building, its purpose is to ventilate smoke from the shaft--There was a discussion of keeping the roof access port or not - Not won--Mr. Booth talked about alternates, and there was a long discussion of how to adjust the work.

Rob made a motion, seconded by Carl, to adjourn the meeting. The Committee voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting at 8:45 pm.
