<p>6:45pm Meeting Called to Order</p>	<p>Present were Stanley Selkow, Gary Menin and David Favreau, Kathleen Nickerson</p> <p>2/24/11 BOH Minutes accepted.</p> <p>4/14/2011, 5/12/2011, 6/9/2011 BOH Meetings agreed to.</p> <p>Title 5 Inspection Fee...it was agreed to put in the new BOH regulations that all Title 5's need to be scheduled through the BOH as the Agent needs to be present. The fee will be \$50.00.</p> <p>East Lake Waushacum Sewering....Wastewater System Feasibility study financing...approximately \$8,000. How do we do it? David Favreau to look into what happened with the Campground Sewering project and DEP.</p> <p>Water Body Definition came up for discussion...there is one in Title 5; however, Sterling's is different. Should we adopt the one in Title 5.</p> <p>Rabies Clinic will be held on Saturday, March 19, 2011</p> <p>Coalition jackets have arrived...large and extra large.....each group got two, 1 each, of the aforementioned sizes. They are in the BOH Office.</p> <p>Permits requiring signatures were signed.</p>
<p>7:00pm 50 Beaman Road</p>	<p>Chris Knuth, Geo-Services presented for the Sweeney's at 50 Beaman Road. He was looking for a LUA (Local Upgrade Approval) request on G.S. File #11-03:</p> <p>310 CMR 15.405(1)(g):...offset from SAS to water supply well...100' required; proposed 92'</p> <p>Final agreement was that the 100' will be maintained with an impervious barrier. Chris will show David the corrected plans. David will review and give go ahead if criteria met.</p> <p>310 CMR 15.405(1)(i)...use of sieve analysis in lieu of a perc test.</p> <p>Agreed to.</p> <p>Conservation Commission....determination of applicability shall be filed before construction is started....straw bales and silt fence to be installed prior to starting work....may be April 14, 2011</p>
<p>7:30pm East Lake Waushacum Sewering Initiatives</p>	<p>Thomas G. Page, P.E, Underwood Engineers, & Barbara Roberti, Chair East Lake Waushacum Association joined the meeting. Tom Page presented a possible study outline. The Conservation Commission has an article on this year's warrant asking for \$5000 to do a study. Discussion ensued with the outcome being that the BOH would support such an article on the current warrant contingent on the language to the article to fund a feasibility study for sewerage around the lake. Barbara will note the change in the Article language with Terri Ackerman.</p>
