Due to a severe ice storm on December 12, 2008, an emergency meeting was held by the Board of Selectmen at the Sterling Police Station.

The meeting was called to order at 2:15 PM.

Present were Selectmen Donlin Murray, Richard Sheppard and Paul Sushchyk , Fire Chief David Hurlbut , Police Chief Gary Chamberland , and by conference call Town Administrator, Terri Ackerman. The DPW was unable to attend due to the snow plowing operations.

Status reports were given by each department.

It was reported that fewer than 20 homes remain without power.

There have been no requests for shelter in the last few days.

Due to the current snow storm, the state of emergency is not being lifted now but could be lifted as early as tomorrow night.

The next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday at 11:00 AM.
