Minutes of May 26, 2009

Minutes of May 26, 2009 meeting were read and accepted.  
Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.

John Willman 2 Pine Street visited to report yard flooding in heavy rain. Pipe installed in 2007 cannot handle flow. Requests that further work and/or investigation be done. Prior to two neighborhood septic system installs and the fire station project was completed, water in the yard was not a problem. Camera probe will be done.

Christine Morrison visited to report an incident involving an employee while he was directing traffic. She stated that he used vulgar language and upset her to the point that she reported the incident to the police department. A subsequent conversation with Bill Tuttle did not fully satisfy her, so she came before the board to ask that a protocol be established. She expected that a letter of apology would be forthcoming in a timely manner, but it was not. She has since received same from Bill and the employee.

Barbara Roberti visited as Conservation Chairman regarding the former Mudgett property owned by the town and discussed the Town Meeting. She asked what the DPW could do to improve access and possibly provide for parking. The board will meet her at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday morning, May 30, 2009.

Barbara Roberti visited as a member of the Lake Association with regard to day passes issued to the lake, in particular with regard to bass tournaments. She reported that they show no regard to residents. She also expressed concern that there is no wash station for visiting boats.

Bill Tuttle report:

1. Gates Road culvert has been plated and weight limit signs are in place.
2. Chipper demo units are coming in for trial use.
3. Garland Construction will be in town tomorrow 5/27/2009 to do an overview of the town and intends to start debris cleanup 6/8/2009.
4. One bid was received for the Muddy Pond project. The project will be re-bid.

Proposal made and passed to accept the water conservation bylaw as submitted by the water department superintendent. Vote taken was 3-0 in favor of same.
