

MINUTES, STERLING OPEN SPACE IMPLEMENTATION COMMITTEE

Meeting, July 10, 2008

Attendance: Brian Cline (chair), Bill Ayadi, Joyce Hinckley, Maryanne Macleod, Peder C. Pedersen (secretary).

The meeting was called to order at 7:25 PM.

ADA requirements were reviewed. The state wants us to assess all parcels owned by the town for recreation or conservation use. The OSIC plan is to update the Open Space Plan with all the parcels and structures that have undergone ADA assessment at this point and to create a plan for further assessment and implementation. Any updates to ADA accessibility should also be included. The resignation of the ADA Coordinator earlier in 2008 makes completion of this section challenging.

Section 5 of the Open Space Plan, which details “inventory of lands of Conservation and Recreation Interest”, was presented by Bill Ayadi, and discussed.

Section 3C of the Open Space Plan, “Population Characteristics,” was reviewed by Joyce Hinckley and discussed. It was found that this chapter contained much useful and up-to-date information, and an appreciation for Joyce’s major effort in assembling this data was expressed.
