Meeting:

Chairman Sushchuk called the meeting to order at 6:35pm. Roll call established that Selectmen Paul Sushchuk, Ron Furmaniuk and Brian Patacchiola were present.

VOTE: Selectman Paul Sushchuk made a motion to accept the cap of 1.5 Million on the Senior Center Article as proposed by the Finance Committee. Discussion ensued. The consensus of the Board was to endorse and support the Senior Center Building Committee.
AMENDMENT TO MOTION: Selectman Patacchiola made an amendment to officially support the Senior Center Building Committee. Selectman Furmaniuk 2nd. All in favor of this amendment.

VOTE: Chairman Sushchuk made the motion to support the Finance Committee's recommendation for a 1.5 million dollar cap on the Senior Center Article. Selectman Furmaniuk – Nay. Selectman Patacchiola Nay. All opposed.

Assign Temporary
Police Sergeant

Chief Gary Chamberland requested that the Board rescind the temporary appointment of Detective, David Johnson as the acting Sergeant on the midnight shift. The chief reported that for personal reasons, Detective Johnson wishes to return to his former shift. **VOTE:** Selectman Sushchuk made the motion to rescind the appointment. Selectman Furmaniuk 2nd. All in favor.

Chief Chamberland requested that Officer Craig Pomeroy be appointed as acting sergeant on the midnight shift. **VOTE:** Selectman Sushchuk made the motion to appoint Officer Craig Pomeroy to the temporary position of Acting Sergeant, for the balance of Officer Happy's leave of absence. This appointment is to be effective forthwith. Selectman Furmaniuk 2nd. All in favor.

Chairman Sushchuk recessed the meeting until the start of the Special Town Meeting at 7:00. The meeting was adjourned at the close of Town Meeting.
