VOTE: Selectman Sushchyk made the motion to appoint Officer Craig Pomeroy to the temporary position of Acting Sergeant, for the balance of Officer Happy's leave of absence. This appointment is to be effective forthwith. Selectman Furmaniuk 2 nd . All in favor.
