7:45 PM: Pursuant to MGL ch 131 s 40 as amended there will be a public meeting on a request for a determination by Sean Kilcoyne for the construction of an entrance to a lot Prats Junction Road Map 50 Lot 2.

This was given leave to withdraw without prejudice by motion of MR. Curtin and a second by Mr. Michalak.

8:00 PM: Pursuant to MGL ch 131 s 40 as amended there will be a public hearing on a Notice of Intent by Mass DOT for tree removal to facilitate runway and airport sight distance requirements at Sterling Airport 121 Greenland road.

Mass DOT was present and outlined FAA requirements for Sterling Airport. B& C delineated the area and outlined 3 different wetland areas and the areas near and within the wetland

Were outlined for the commission. Mr. Marro inspected the delineation and reported that he had no issue with it. There will be no underbrush cutting or grading but the trees will be mostly clear cut in order to provide sight distance.

Catherine Beyer 71 Lakeshore Drive noted where her land is in relation to the airport. She cited a pine tree that she felt should come down. The applicant agreed to the tree. Mr. Curtin motioned to approve a standard OOC for the project. Mr. Mosley seconded and the Commission voted unanimously.
