- 3.1 New article Chair Roberti noted to the commission that Mr. Marro has submitted a draft warrant article for obtaining 9,000 dollars for further treatments of the lake and the emergent weeds at town beach. She noted that the estimated costs totaled about 18,000 dollars and the east lake association would pay the remaining costs.
- Mr. Marro noted that he also submitted for a partnership grant through DCR, if successful would cut the towns share of the cost in half. After consideration, Mr. Mosley moved to ratify the warrant article submission, Mr. Curtin seconded and the commission voted unanimously
 - 3.2 Current proposal from Solitude Lake Management (FKA-Lycott) for East Lake Waushacum Mr Marro reviewed the proposals for the work on the lake this year. Proposals included Emergent weed treatment, Loose-strife treatment, Copper Sulfate in lake and lab testing. Mr. Pineo voiced a concern about approving the contracts before the money is approved by the townspeople at town meeting. After some discussion, The Commission voted to authorize Mr. Marro to execute the agreements only after the town meeting dependent on the townspeople voting to approve the appropriation.
