7:30 PM In accordance with MGL ch 131 s 40 as amended, there will be a public meeting on a request for a determination made by John Powell for the construction of a shed at 24 North Cove Road The Public meeting will be convened on May 19 2020 as a scheduled Zoom meeting.

John Powell presented the commission with a sketch diagram showing the outline for a shed that was 24 feet from the water's edge. Mr. Marro, after reviewing the site recommended a negative determination as there was no apparent wetland impact that would result. Mr. Michalak recommended a negative determination, Mr. Pineo seconded and the commission unanimously approved the motion by roll call vote.

7:40 PM: In accordance with MGL ch 131 s 40 as amended, there will be a public meeting on a request for a determination made by John Filgate for the construction of a retaining wall at 18 Square shire Road within various rights of way within the town of Sterling. The Public meeting will be convened on May 19 2020 as a scheduled Zoom meeting.

John Filgate appeared before the commission. Ms. Valentine and MR Marro recounted that this was brought to the commission as a result of an enforcement order. After consideration it was noted the wall was a preexisting 35 foot section of wall being updated. Ms. Valentine moved for a negative determination with the conditions the erosion protection that she and Mr. Marro ordered on site be maintained through the life of the project. Mr. Michalak seconded and the commission voted unanimously by roll call vote to approve the motion



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7 : 50 pm : In accordance with MGL ch 131 s 40 as amended, there will be a public meeting on a request for a determination made by DCR at a lot next to 71 South Nelson Road to demolish and remove the dilapidated horse feeding sheds and the former riding ring structures from this property. The site is primarily composed of farm fields and is developed with a horse riding arena and horse feeding sheds. The site is fairly flat.

Paula Davidson of DCR narrated the project for the commission. MR Michalak moved to isse a negative determination. Mr. Pavlowich seconded and the commission approved the motion by unanimous roll call vote.
