7:30 P.M.: Pursuant to MGL ch 131 s 40 as amended, the Sterling Conservation Commission will have a CONTINUED PUBLIC HEARING on a Notice of Intent by ALMIK Construction for the Construction of 8 Duplex units at 81 Chace Hill Road Work is within the buffer zone.

MM recounted the site walk with Robert Traux, who was representing the applicant. MM also noted that his review of the narrative concerning the cold water fishery and found no issues with it. Mr Michalak recounted the site walk with Ms Hastings, PWS, who agreed to move and expand the replication area. MM noted the updated replication as accurately reflected on the plans.

Mr. Michalak moved to issue an Order of Conditions. Ms Valentine seconded and the commission approved the motion by unanimous roll call vote
