7:50 PM Pursuant to MGL ch 131 s 40 as amended, the Sterling Conservation Commission will have public meeting on a Notice of Intent by Magay Family Trust for the construction of a driveway crossing to access a future single family home at 29 Westland Farm Road

Neil Gorman appeared before the commission. He recalled a site visit Mr. Marro had with the applicant and Mr. Marro had advised the wetland area was a qualified intermittent stream and a crossing required a notice of intent. Replication was provided and Mr. Marro indicated he was satisfied. After examining the crossing, the commission issued a standard order of conditions based on the submitted plan by a motion of Mr Michalak and a second by Mr Pineo.
