Superintendent Report DPW

- Upper North Row Road edging taking place currently
- Rte. 140 section from Beaman to Princeton Road will be edged next
- Ch. 90 paper work has been sent for approval for the Rte. 140 mill/overlay project
- Ch. 90 approval has been received for Upper North Row Road rebuild, replace five culverts, a stone culvert and two handmade mini catch basins
- Ch. 90 approval has been received for chip/crack sealing of Laurelwood, Kilburn, Bean, and Mortimer Roads
- Twine Road dig out and replace culvert and reopen road
- T Ball field on Redstone Hill Road will have tree branches cleared 10 feet up from under the trees to
 open it up and clean it up to make parking there. The area will be edged with telephone poles. Parking
 will not be allowed at Hillside Cemetery, as has been the case in past years, for those using the ball field.

Superintendent Report Water

- The Flanagan Hill Road Simpson project has a start date of April 6. The state will be notified five days ahead of the start date of the project. Per Water Department policy required for the project will be a "T", three gate valves, and one length of pipe past the "T"
