 - S. Valentine said that she will check on the bridge. She also noted that scouts have marked the boundaries of the Conservation Commission property. Also noted that the Conservation Commission is looking for volunteers to work on improvements to the trailhead.
- J. Keay reported that the Stillwater Basin Trail is in good shape.
- 6. Peg's Pond Trail Progress
- S. Valentine reported she has been attempting to contact the Director of Vocational Programs at Montachusett Regional Vocational Technical High School concerning help with refurbishing the Sterling Greenery Community Park.
- J. Keay reported that he has completed and submitted the application form for the AARP Community Challenge Grant. We will know if it has been accepted by Mid-May. He also noted that the application period for the 2023 Massachusetts PARC grant has opened, and he has begun to research the application process. The award date for the grant is November, 2022.
- 7. Allenwood Trail re-route
- C. Plaisted reported that he has had a response from the affected landowner, but there was no comment about the proposed rerouting of the trail. OSIC will endeavor to make further contact to make sure the reroute is satisfactory.
