FULL TIME POLICE OFFICER

1. MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- Citizen of the United States at date of appointment
- Valid drivers license
- High School Diploma or Equivalent (College degree preferred).
- Ability to pass written test, medical, PAT, fitness and psychological examinations.
- Ability to pass drug, background and firearms examinations
- Ability to obtain a License to carry a firearm
- No significant criminal record (felonies, domestic) or traffic record
- Non-smoker
- 15 Mile residency requirement

2. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Under the direction of officers who provide instruction and training, assign work and review performance; enforce criminal and motor vehicle laws, rules and regulations within assigned jurisdiction; preserve the public peace; provide protection and assistance to the public; investigate suspected violations such as those relative to motor vehicle operations; public disturbances and other misdemeanors and felonies by stopping motor vehicles or persons, by observing suspicious persons, activities or establishments, and by conducting searches and investigations; respond to emergency situations, testify in court and perform related duties as required and directed.

3. SALARY

The salary is set by contractual agreement with the Town; minimum starting wage is \$56,022. Candidates who are required to attend a full time academy will be compensated at a lower rate while attending academy. Other benefits are outlined in a collective bargaining agreement.
