3. Provide (2) two letters of reference along with the contact information from any two of the following:
 - a. Employer, teacher/guidance counselor, school or community leader, police officer, clergy, town business owner, coach/leader of extra-curricular involvement
4. Provide a current WRHS transcript: Applicants must be a member of the graduating class of 2022 and in good standing.
