Birds entering the building continue to be an issue.

Services: Highlight was presentation by Sterling Olympian Fred Borchelt in the One Book / One Town program.

Children's: Story Hours were cut back with the maternity absence of the Youth Services librarian. The summer reading program and contests are continuing.

Other:

The Friends have purchased a pass for the New England Aquarium and have also contributed \$1000 toward E-books.
