CONDITIONS:

1. Any disturbance within a wetland, such as breaching of a beaver dam or the installation of water leveling devices, may only be performed with the permission of the Conservation Commission.
2. Emergency Certification is valid for ten days after Board of Health approval. Two subsequent ten-day emergency permits can e issued while a 30-day extension permit is obtained from the Department of Fish and Wildlife.
3. The Permit/Emergency Certification authorized the applicant to remedy the threat in one of three ways:
 - a. Use of Conibear or box or cage-type traps is subject to Department of Fish and Wildlife regulation.
 - b. Breaching dams, dikes, bogs or berms, subject to determinations and conditions of the Sterling Conservation Commission.
 - c. Use of any non-lethal management or water-flow devices, subject to determinations and conditions of the Conservation Commission.
