General Business Updates

- 1. Complaint (Favreau)...odor at Chace Hill Road and Kendall Hill Road...this has been occurring for years. It is a natural process of bio-degrading of leaves, etc. along with beaver construction in the area. It smells like sulfur dioxide.
- 2. Complaint (Favreau)...sewage running down driveway of 24 Clinton Road; agent saw nothing but will continue to monitor.
- 3. MHOA / DEP Seminar (Favreau) 4/7/2015 will be attending at Devens.
- 4. Finance Committee Update....Hoffman, Clark and Favreau attended. The BOH presented the FY 16 budget and cover letter and went through a limited amount of inspections and projected revenues for the year. The BOH updated the Finance Committee members that we have formally revised our fee schedule. Finance Committee asked for the BOH position with regards to the warrant article request for ELW monitoring and treatment. Review at the April Meeting and send letter thereafter with the Board's answer. Discussion regarding a need for an individual to take minutes for the BOH. ELW Report: Barbara Roberti has provided a copy of the ELW year-end report and would like to discuss this with the BOH at the April 2015 meeting... David will send an electronic copy to all BOH members for review in advance of this meeting.

10 Pikes Hill, Chris Knuth...variance request from wetland to SAS 100' required, 70' proposed; variance request from wetland to septic tank 100' required, 52' proposed; variance request from wetland to pump chamber 100' required, 67' proposed; variance request leaching field required 1000 sf, 750 sf proposed. BOH will have discussion and will vote at April 9, 2015 Meeting.

5 Hawkins Lane, Gerald Buzanski...variance request to reduce the minimum separation distance from high groundwater and the SAS from 4' to 3'; variance request from foundation wall (bulkhead entry) to SAS required 20', 11.5 proposed; variance to do 2' wide trenches rather than 3' wide trenches. Suggested that a poly barrier be put in place to prevent water going through or under the bulkhead. BOH will have discussion and will vote at April 9, 2015 Meeting at 7pm.
