The southerly limit of this project is a pavement joint near the intersection with Western Avenue (mm $29.8\pm$) in the Town of West Boylston. The northerly limit is at the end of state highway located near the center of the Town of Sterling (mm $33.4\pm$). The total length of the project is approximately 3.6 miles
