Superintendent Report DPW


- Paul Lyons stated approximately 20 missing street signs have been replaced.
- The Sterling Town Library project to start soon with a plan to beat the Winter weather
- Truck #9 was repaired by Certified Auto & Truck Repair of Clinton and is running.
- Paul Lyons would like to hire two truck drivers/laborers, the money is in the budget. They would be hired with the understanding that they will be cross-trained to do everything, not just for driving truck.
- Paul Lyons will be attending the All Boards meeting on November 18th at 6:30pm.
- Paul Lyons went with a rep from All States Materials Group to look at recently re-surfaced roads using rubber chip seal under 1 ½ inches of asphalt. This process has shown to wear well. Paul will meet with them again in the Spring to discuss possible options for paving in Sterling.
- Paul Lyons recommended a self-contained unit for the loader for roadside mowing and would like to include in a capital budget proposal.

- Paul Lyons received a thank you from Jamie Carr of the DCR for getting required reporting up to date.
- DCR has granted access to their land on John Dee Rd for well testing.
