Minutes of October 12, 2021 passed 3-0

Public Session: Arden Sonnenberg praised the Water Department for their work during a recent appointment at her home.

- Updated Right of Way Policy was presented. Blaine Bershad made a motion to accept the policy with minor changes. Andrew Parker seconded. Motion was passed 3-0.
- Updated Mailbox Policy was presented. Board suggested some changes prior to approval.
 Revised policy will be presented at the next meeting.
- Mr. Mouradian advised the Board that considering the time of year and current status of Town Hall, he did not recommend perusing a special town meeting at this time.
- Casella Contract still with Town Legal Counsel. There was a brief discussion about using an electric truck, but the consensus was that the technology was too new.
- Update 14 Clemence Ave a Catch Basin was replaced. DPW crew dug out a large area and wrapped with filter fabric and installed a leaching catch basin. It was then filled with crushed stone and backfilled with subbase.
- Discussion of proposed walkway for 37 Main Street Coffee Shop- Board recommended that walkway be ADA compliant and meet with current sidewalk. Mr. Bershad recommended a porous medium be investigated for the walkway.
- Brush Dump Tree Disposal DPW and SMLD are working together to remove the existing debris and set procedures for future dumping.
- A discussion on the time clock was had, DPW will be moving away from time clock system and moving to an overtime sheet system.
- Superintendent updated the Board on current DPW and Water projects.
 - 1. Tire replacement of 4 trucks
 - 2. Hydrant replacement on Rt 140 after accident
 - 3. Sensors-wireless Snow & Ice -pavement temperature to be purchased
 - 4. Public Records request regarding composting
 - 5. Bucket truck needs substantial repairs, not recommending repairs at this time
 - 6. Sterling Inn it was requested by the Town treasurer that the DPW clear overgrowth prior to auction on 12/10
 - 7. Snow equipment ready to go
 - 8. Water billing- working towards a meter reading solution
- Other issues or concerns discussed: agenda format, communicating using town website and solar flashing stop signs
