Public Session: No one spoke

- Sean Gaudette was introduced as the new Police Chief for the Town of Sterling. The DPW Board addressed the downtown- parking issues during the winter and during street sweeping with Chief Gaudette. Deane Day stated he would like to work with the Police Department to enforce no overnight parking. Andrew Parking believed issuing warnings and educating rather than ticketing residents would be helpful. Chief Gaidette stated that a good place to start would be to get a list of the Landlords and let them inform the tenants. Stop signs was the next topic of discussion. Solar powered stop signs will help alert drivers to slow down and stop. Mr. Mouradian thought that the blinking "Please Slow Down signs" has had an impact for slowing traffic down.

Andrew made a motion to allow auction of the above items, Blaine seconded the motion.


Motion passed 3-0
