 - Peder Pedersen reported that Judi Barrett is interested. Committee voted unanimously to contact her and invite her to attend next OSIC meeting on February 21st. Marion Larson and Peder Pedersen may meet with her ahead of time.
- 6. Town Administrator's request for OSIC representatives on the town's Master Plan Committee.
- Peder Pedersen moved and Jim Wilkinson seconded that OSIC respond positively to Ross Perry's invitation.
 - Rob Protano indicated his willingness to serve as a permanent member of Master Plan Committee if asked.
 - Committee unanimously voted to accept motion and support Rob Protano as permanent member, with other OSIC members contributing to Master Plan Committee deliberations as appropriate.

 - Peder Pedersen reported that Charles Plaistead is willing to join OSIC. Peder will approach him with a formal offer to join Committee.
