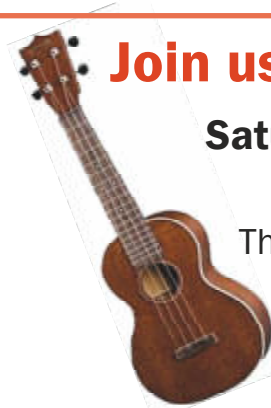

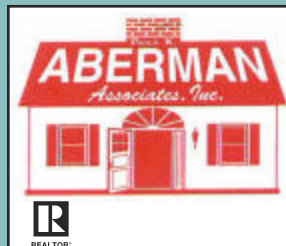

Community Response:

The Results from the Age and Dementia Friendly Survey

Tuesday September 18th at 6pm

In May, the Sterling Council On Aging was awarded a grant to explore community perceptions regarding age and dementia-friendliness. A survey comprised of thirty-three multiple choice questions and one free response was prepared to assess age and dementia-related views focused upon eight major areas including aging in the community, outdoor spaces and buildings, housing, transportation, health and wellness, social interaction, volunteerism/civic engagement, and availability of public technology. The survey was mailed to 1000 Sterling households of all ages selected at random.

The results of this survey indicate a relatively high degree of satisfaction with aging in the Town of Sterling while identifying several areas of need. Join us for an in depth look at the survey results and just how these results may provide guidance for future actions and goal setting.

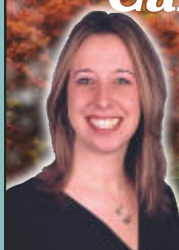

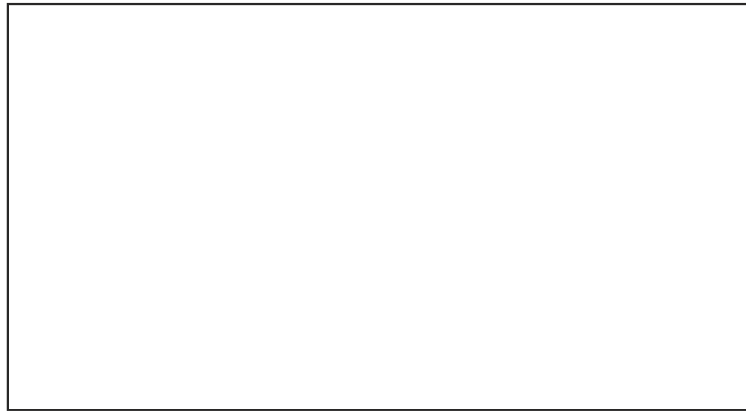

Mixed Media by Denis Coughlin Artist's Reception

Denis, a nationally acclaimed song writer, has been performing in the Boston - Central Mass area for over twenty years. After selling his business in 2013, he took up his brushes and started a life-long desire to paint. Shortly after joining the Princeton Arts Society in 2014, he began to grow his art delving into oil, watercolor, and acrylics. Working with the area's finest artists he has developed a style and technique that closely resembles his penchant for story telling as a song writer. There are at least a thousand words with each piece he produces.
