

Free COVID-19 OTC Tests for Medicare Beneficiaries

Americans with Medicare Part B, including those enrolled in a Medicare Advantage plan, now have access to Food and Drug Administration (FDA) approved, authorized, or cleared over-the-counter COVID-19 tests at no cost. People with Medicare can get up to eight tests per calendar month from participating pharmacies and health care providers for the duration of the COVID-19 public health emergency.

Participating pharmacies include Rite Aid, Hannaford, Stop & Shop, Walgreens and Walmart.


