- Rosanne will contact the Town hall re the Gazebo condition. Checked... Kama will ask Facilities for an assessment....
  - Beth visited, assessed Gazebo, took pictures, sent them to the Town Hall, Patrice, Town Facilities Manager.
  - Rosanne sent message to Select Board and Facilities Manager. Manager replied that it wouldn't be done before 2022 (budget restraints and increase in material costs).
    - Maureen called Rosanne to state that it will be remedied by our event. She knows someone who may be willing to fund the \$\$\$. Will check on this.
