Sewer Feasibility
Study “kick-off”
meeting

The purpose of the meeting was to initiate the sewer feasibility study.

Marcia Berger and John Hume presented.

Scope:

1. Meet with Sterling Town Officials to establish which problems need to be solved and to collect data to address same (consensus was that the predominant goal is to consider a sewer system that would ultimately help the Town to sustain current industry and increase the Town's option, in the future, of encouraging new businesses.)
2. Estimate current and future flow computations
3. Prepare a map-level layout to include recommended alternatives
4. Evaluate discharging systems and disposal options
5. Develop a feasibility opinion of probable construction cost for each alternative
6. Provide data which includes project narrative of work performed, mapping, locations, soft and hard project costs and likely timeline
7. Address comments regarding draft report
8. Present final report at a public meeting

A working committee will help establish the exact area that should be included in the study.

Some of the Boards and Committees that will be contacted for vital input are; the Zoning Board, the Board of Health, DPW/Water Department, Economic Development Committee, and Conservation.
